



The Icenian Trophy



Format

- 1.1 The Icenian Trophy is a team competition that takes place alongside the biennial Icenian orienteering competition.
- 1.2 The eight highest-scoring finishers from each club contribute to the overall team total.
- 1.3 The Icenian Trophy is awarded to the team with the highest score after courses close.

Eligibility

- 2.1 In order to score, a competitor must have completed at least the suggested course for their class.

2.1a Suggested courses are shown in the following table:

Course	M Class	W Class
Black	M21	
Brown	M35, M40	
Blue	M16, M18, M20, M45, M50, M55, M60	W21, W35, W40
Green	M65, M70	W16, W18, W20, W45, W50, W55, W60
V Short Green	M75, M80, M85, M90	W65, W70, W75, W80, W85, W90
Light Green	M14	W14
Orange	M12	W12
Yellow	M10	W10

- 2.2 For the Icenian itself, competitors are permitted to ‘run down’. This entails competing on a course lower down in the table than their suggested course (i.e. of lower technical difficulty and/or distance). ‘Running up’ is likewise permitted.
 - 2.2a Competitors running down cannot contribute to their club’s total score in the Icenian Trophy.
 - 2.2b Conversely, competitors running up can contribute to the Icenian Trophy. These orienteers will earn a score relative to other competitors on the same course.
- 2.3 Only people belonging to the same BOF-affiliated club may score for the same team; there will be no ad-hoc entries to the Icenian Trophy.
- 2.4 In order to score, a competitor must have a valid finish (no mispunches or disqualifications).

Scoring

- 3.1 Scoring for M categories is calculated relative to the first-placed male finisher on their course.

3.2 Scoring for W categories is calculated relative to the first-placed female finisher on their course.

3.3 The formula used to calculate an individual's score will be:

$$\frac{\text{Reference time (s)}}{\text{Competitor's time (s)}} \times 100$$

3.3a The reference time is that of the first-placed M/W finisher completing the course.

3.3b Consequently, the highest possible score is 100 per individual, or 800 for a team.

Misc

4.1 Team scores are calculated via the Icenian Trophy spreadsheet.

4.1a Only an inducted official may enter the top eight scorers of each club.

4.2 For the purposes of this document, the terms 'male' and female' refer to individuals in classes designated 'M' or 'W' only, as is sporting convention. This does not necessarily designate the gender that an individual identifies with.
